Video Submission and Recording Guidelines for the Bargad Application

Please read these before submitting the video components of the Bargad Application

GUIDELINES FOR VIDEO SUBMISSION:

1. Please name all your video files according to the following formats:

- For the Personal Context question: 'NAME_PersonalContext_DateOfBirth' E.g:

Anirudh_PersonalContext_02061999

- For the Statement of Purpose (SOP) questions: Please number videos 1, or 2 respectively based on which question you are responding to.

E.g: **Anirudh_SOP2_02061999**

- For the Audition Videos: Please number the videos 1 or 2

E.g: **Anirudh_Audition1_02061999**

Please format your date of birth in ddmmyyyy format, with no spaces, slashes, or hyphens

2. Submitting the Videos

- As files uploaded as part of your online form
- As links for unlisted YouTube videos - please copy and paste the links on the online form in the appropriate space

- Please do not remove the video from your YouTube account for the next 6 months after the upload

GUIDELINES FOR RECORDING YOUR VIDEOS:

- Keep the camera still, at eye level and in **landscape mode** while recording
- Try to keep a non-distracting and neat background if possible
- Ensure that background noise is kept to a minimum
- Record it in good lighting: natural daylight is preferred but you can also use lights available to you in your house as well
- For Part 2 of the application - keep the frame in a mid-shot where the upper half of your body is clearly visible
- For Part 3 of the application -
 - ***For Video 1 - The Monologue:***
 - Frame in a mid shot (from your waist to the top of your head).
 - Sit or stand depending on what feels comfortable/appropriate for the scene. - Don't go too far from the camera (unless you have an external microphone). ○
 - ***For Video 2 - Performance Video:***
 - Keep the frame in a wide shot where your full body is visible.
- Record all the videos in a single take without any cuts or jerks in the frame.
